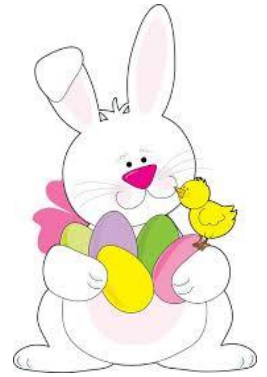


FUN 'N' DANCE LTD. - APRIL NEWSLETTER 2025

April Fees

April fees are now due and *we would prefer fees to be paid by email transfer to office@funndance.com* Monthly fees are due on the **1st day of each month** unless an alternative date has been arranged with Miss Julie.

Last Class for Storybook Ballet

A reminder that the last Storybook Ballet class will be held on **Saturday, June 7**, there will be in-person parent viewing on this date. The last monthly fee payment for Storybook ballet will be due on **May 1, 2025**.

2025 YEAR-END PERFORMANCE – “ANYTHING GOES!”

Our year-end performance, “*Anything Goes!*” will take place at the end of May at the *university theatre* in the *University of Calgary*.

The performance will involve all students currently registered in the school except for students in our *Storybook Ballet and Adult classes*. Our rehearsal day at the theatre is booked for **Thursday May 22** (*rehearsals will take place throughout the day with a dress rehearsal starting at 6.00pm, so please be aware that some school will have to be missed*). There will be 2 performances, one on **Friday May 23** and the second performance on **Saturday May 24** both starting at 6.00pm.

Year-End Performance Fees & Consent Forms

At the beginning of March, all students in participating classes received a **performance consent form** by e-mail; this form should now have been completed, signed and returned with the correct performance fee to Miss Julie. The performance fee helps cover the cost of renting the theatre for 3 days and includes a student’s costume rental fee. By returning the completed form and performance fee, you are confirming your child’s participation in the year-end performance. If you have NOT yet returned your consent form, then please do so **as soon as possible** as Miss Julie needs to know *immediately* of anyone unable to participate in the performance. This is very important as choreography and organization of costumes is already well underway. N.B.

Students should only attend on the days that they are needed (please refer to the lists above). Younger students in *Pre-Primary, Primary and Grade 1 Ballet, Primary Tap/Jazz, Jr. Hip-Hop and Beginner Acro.* will not be expected to stay for the full rehearsal and parents should arrange to pick them up at **6.00pm**. ALL other students will be expected to be in attendance from **4.30pm to 7.00pm** and we would recommend that they bring something non-messy to eat and drink and a quiet activity for when they are not dancing. Rehearsals and Dress Rehearsal at the University Theatre – Thursday, May 22

A reminder that on **Thursday, May 22** we will be holding rehearsals *throughout* the day at the **university theatre** (*therefore students will have to miss some school*) followed by a full dress rehearsal starting at *6.00pm*. The **senior ballet students** (i.e. Inter. Fdn. Ballet and higher) will be at the theatre in the morning on **Thursday, May 22** until the end of dress rehearsal. All other students will be required to be at the theatre for afternoon spacing rehearsals **and** the dress rehearsal (a detailed schedule for the full day of rehearsals will be in the May newsletter). Students should make sure that they have brought plenty to eat and drink with them to the theatre as well as homework and other quiet activities to keep them occupied while they are not rehearsing. *A reminder that cell phones or ipads/laptops will be allowed in the dressing rooms for entertainment and homework purposes **ONLY**, the use of social media and taking photos/videos in the dressing rooms is **strictly forbidden** and will be closely monitored by parent volunteers and teachers.*

Miss Julie is still confirming the rehearsal schedule for **Thursday, May 22**, so should there be any concerns regarding students missing school, then please let Miss Julie know *as soon as possible* so she can address them, she appreciates that it is a busy time of year for everybody. Thank you!

Costumes

Costuming for our year-end performance is well underway and Miss Julie would like to say a **big 'thank you'** to all the parents who have volunteered to act as the 'group parent' for their child's class, this makes the organization of costumes for each class a lot easier.

Police Information Check for Parents Volunteering at Year-End Performance

To ensure a safe, secure and enjoyable environment for everyone during our year-end performance, we are requesting that all parents volunteering backstage during the rehearsal day and both performances please complete a 'Police Information Check (PIC)' including a 'vulnerable sector check'.

Tickets for the Year-End Performance

Tickets for both performances will be available for purchase online starting **April 15**. Details on how to purchase tickets online will be emailed to families once the tickets are released. The price of advance tickets purchased online is **\$27.00 for general admission** i.e. adults, children, students and seniors are all the same price (GST is included in this price). Tickets can also be purchased on both performance days prior to the performance at the box-office; box-office tickets cost **\$29.00**. There is no limit on the number of tickets purchased per family and the students would appreciate a large and enthusiastic audience to perform for.

Photo Day

Our photo day for the year-end performance will take place on **Saturday May 10** in the dance studio at the Rosedale community centre in the afternoon and evening. Cory Harding will be coming to take group and individual photos of the dancers in their costumes. Information on how to order photos online will be emailed to parents. A detailed schedule for the photo session will be made available as soon as it is confirmed.

Advertising in the Program

Miss Julie would like to offer the opportunity for local businesses to advertise in the year-end performance program. The cost of advertising is **\$65.00** for a *business card size* advertisement and the money would be put towards the cost of printing the recital program and other performance costs. All adverts need to be handed in to Miss Julie **no later than April 30th**. Thank you for your support.

IN-SCHOOL REGISTRATION FOR 2025/2026

In June we will be holding our *in-school* registration. This registration is open to all students currently enrolled in the school and siblings are also welcome to register at this time. A *tentative* schedule for the 2025/2026 school year will be available and by registering early, parents will **not** be required to pay the registration fee.

Registration information will be emailed to each family in June and will include a class schedule, list of fees, registration form, medical/waiver of liability form and consent to receive emails form.
